Amsterdam Food by Foot Walking Tour

# Marken, Volendam, & Windmills Tour

This excursion takes you to the countryside north of Amsterdam, to the edge of the river Zaan, where you will visit windmill village 'de Zaanse Schans', with its characteristic green wooden houses. On the turn of the 18th century this district was an industrial area with approximately 700 windmills in use. Through typical Dutch scenery we continue to Volendam for a city walk and the traditional fisherman's village of Marken, situated on the shores of the former Zuiderzee.
